THE PRINCIPLE OF SHARING

Sharing depends upon the right circulation of energies and forces. In an age of intense competition ideas about sharing are coming more into the public domain in response to economic inequality and the unfair distribution of resources. Shared public services that serve the common good have been with us for many years and now the concept of a sharing economy is emerging via electronic networks and marketing, the sharing of information via social networking sites and file sharing on the internet.

The Triangles work is based upon the idea that subtle energies and forces are circulating throughout the etheric web which vitalises the physical form. The power of thought sends these energies on their way and they become a shared resource on the mental plane. All of the many inspiring sharing initiatives in the world are the result of the creative thought of some mind or group of minds whose hearts have no boundaries.

The etheric or energy body which shapes the human form is an integral part of the etheric body of the planet and the solar system. According to the Ageless Wisdom teachings "the field of space is etheric in nature" and is an "entity". Through this etheric network every human being is related to every other expression of the divine Life. Lines of light circulate through the etheric field throughout the human and sub-human kingdoms of nature; there is a constant circulation with energies passing into, through, and out of the body of manifestation. THE CIRCLE OF LOVE

The daily practice of Triangles involves visualizing and creating within a triangular formation, linking with our co-workers throughout the world, drawing upon the inner reservoirs of spiritual energy and releasing and circulating them through the etheric network surrounding the planet.

And although we work at building and enlivening a triangular network we likewise know that that network is constructed within an etheric spheroidal structure that is the etheric counterpart to our Earth. The essential work of Triangles is "to facilitate the work of distributing the pure incoming love energy (expressing itself as light and as goodwill) into the Hierarchy and Humanity" (Alice Bailey). As we hold this simplicity and potency of purpose in our minds and hearts we can play our part in aiding our Logos to realize his keynote, which is said to be that of relationship.

The circle has no beginning and no end, relating all things within its circumference. It's said that within "the radius of the love of God – the circle of the solar system – all forms, all souls, all lives revolve. Let each son of God enter into this wisdom. Reveal to each the Oneness of the many lives" (Alice Bailey, adapted). As points within points we each work together to radiate love thereby aiding our planet to fulfill not only its individual dharma but also that larger collective Purpose of which our planet is a small yet significant part.

Triangles is a world service activity in which people link in thought in groups of three to create a planetary network of Triangles of light and goodwill. Using a world prayer, the Great Invocation, they invoke light and love as a service to humanity. Further information is available on request from Triangles.
