TITLE: THE ROLE OF GOODWILL IN ADDRESSING HUMANITY'S SERIOUS PROBLEMS OF ECONOMIC INQUALITY, RELIGIOUS DIVISIONS AND DEMAGE TO THE ENVIRONMENT

PREAMBLE

The creator of our universe made all things bright and beautiful, great and small and the occupants of the universe are expected to live in harmony with one another. The occupants of the universe are in four kingdoms: human, animal, plants and minerals. The fifth kingdom is at subjective level and this paper is not concerned with it. Humans are endowed with higher mind of intelligence for the purpose of continuing the creation of the harmony and beauty vision by God for the race. The causes of poverty in these countries are traceable to the mismanagement of the different nation's resources, corruption and greed. The mother earth can sustain the needs of every being on our planet but cannot sustain the greed of men within the body of humanity.

The way out, according to Alice A. Bailey is "The general public must be educated in the principle of right living, goodwill and harmony (...) steadily, regularly and systematically, they must be taught the principles of brotherhood, of an internationalism which is based on goodwill and love of all men, of religious unity and co-operative interdependence. The individual in every nation and group must be taught to play his important part with goodwill and understanding," The group must shoulder its responsibility to other groups, and the responsibility on nation to nation and of all nations to the world of nations must be explained and emphasized.

RELIGIOUS DIVISIONS

Religion, according to the teachings of the Ageless wisdom, is human approach to God, the Creator of all things in the universe. Religious practices came into existence through the Divine teachers who came on earth to teach infant humanity way back to God or Creator. CAUSES OF RELIGIOUS CONFLICT

- > Sense of superiority while others are inferior. Some religious group assumes that their religion is superior to others, so sense of pride crepts into the minds of members of the religious group.
- > Religious conflict is also motivated by the thought of some people that they are fighting for justice in the name of God. Hence they interpret the killing of the other groups as victory over the devil. The other group is regarded as evil.

Humanity will resolve religious divisions and conflict through the individual realizing that we are one with all beings and that having unity of purpose irrespective of one's religion. Understanding and tolerance will build right human relationship between all beings in the world.

DAMAGE TO THE ENVIRONMENT

As the saying goes: No man is an island unto himself. Every man depends on other sources of lives in the planet to be able to exist. The planet earth is the only home for us all. Why damage it? The environment of our planet earth is made up of living organism such as water, climate, soil, air, heat and light. The interactions of these organisms make

5. Wrong Disposal of Toxic chemical waste, plastics and other wastes into the sea, river, and drainage thereby causing damages to the environment.

According to Alice A.
