Nina Meyerhof Ed.D, is a visionary thought leader advocating for children and youth. Together with Domen Kocevar, she is co-founder of One Humanity Institute which is developing the City of Hope project. Nina is president and founder of Children of the Earth, awakening young people to their inner leadership. Observing the Global Silent Minute Dot Maver

The Silent Minute project on the first day of the Festival Week owes its origins to the Silent Minute observed in the UK during the Second World War, and to the inspiring story of its creator, British esoteric writer and thinker, Wellsley Tudor-Pole.
