HOW TO RETURN LIBRARY BOOKS AND TAPES

- 1. The date due stamped in the back of books (or on audio tape #1) represents the regular four week borrowing period plus one week for shipping to you, and is the date you should place materials in the mail for return to the library.
- 2. It is best to save the original wrapping materials for return of books or cassettes. If you must use other wrapping, please be sure that materials are protected and cushioned strongly by heavy cardboard and a padded mailing envelope. Just heavy paper is not sufficient, nor should there be empty space inside the outer packaging for books, or especially cassette tapes, to slide around. CAREFUL WRAPPING GREATLY EXTENDS THE LIFE OF BOOKS AND TAPES.
- 3. Print your return address clearly, as well as our post office mailing address.
- 4. Affix postage in the same amount as was on the original outer wrapper, and mark the package "LIBRARY BOOKS" or "LIBRARY TAPES" for the lowest postal rate. (Use only regular postage, not airmail stamps.)
