




Manifestation: Duality

- Exist on many levels (physical, emotional, mental...)



Subpersonalities and the necessity of dis-identification


- "The various social selves" (William James) ...link to the role we play in society.
- "We are dominated by everything with which our self is identified.
 We can dominate and control everything from which we dis-identify ourselves."
 R. Assagioli
- **Subpersonalities** = identity patterns derives from important relationships that take form of self-images and social role.
- The self = the point of pure self-awareness and will.
- The process of synthesis: integrate and harmonise the various psychological elements within the personality.

How to harmonise the opposites poles?

- 1.) Become aware of one aspect (sub-personality) and its opposite.
- 2.) Adopt the attitude of a detached, neutral observer, listening to both parties to understand the needs underlying each of them.
- 3.) Perceive compatibilities and make compromises in order to satisfy the two sides fairly.

The opposite poles are adjusted from an intermediate centre:

- by reducing the amplitude of the oscillations between the two extremes to get closer to the "middle way".
- or by consciously directing the alternations so that the result is harmonious.
- 4.) Create the synthesis by a higher principle which transforms, sublimates and reabsorbs the two poles into a higher reality.

A sub-personality generally co-exists with an opposite pole.


- The winner >< the loser
